

USPS Postage Rate Increase 2022



In April 2022, the United States Postal Service (USPS) filed notice with the Postal Regulatory Commission (PRC) requesting price changes to take effect July 10, 2022 that are in accordance with approvals provided by the PRC last year. The proposed price changes would raise:

- **Beginning January 2023, Market Dominant price adjustments will occur twice a year (e.g. January 2023, July 2023, January 2024, July 2024, etc.).**
- **First-Class mail would increase by 6.5 percent.**

Effective July 10, 2022 all mail postmarked that day will reflect the approved postage rate increase. Mailings postmarked prior to that date will remain at the current postage rates.
